## Foot Pain & Problems

Do you have foot pain or problems?

The knee is made to bend only in one direction. When the foot over-pronates, the leg rotates inward toward the opposite leg. This causes the knee to flex and extend while pointing inward and not in the normal direction, which can cause knee pain.

----• Knee Pain-

Injury, overuse or conditions causing inflammation involving any of the bones, ligaments or tendons in the foot can cause foot pain. More causes include Poorly fitted shoes, prolonged period on feet, long walks or running marathons, sprains, strains, or trauma.

• Foot Pain

If the normal way of walking is painful, we instinctively change our walking pattern. This changes the mechanics of your ankle joint, eventually causing ankle pain. This change in your walking pattern can also affect the lower back.

- Back Pain ---

Plantar fasciitis typically causes a stabbing pain in the bottom of your foot near the heel. The pain is usually the worst with the first few steps after awakening, although it can also be triggered by long periods of standing or rising from sitting.




Over the counter Inserts


